Dear Parents and Members of the 2017/18 "Band of Class,"

This document contains information concerning the Ross Senior High School Band Camp. The camp program is made possible by the Ross Band Boosters of the Ross Local School District. The camp is organized by the Band Director and the Camp Lebanon Director. The cost for each band member is \$280.00. This fee includes all meals, lodging, a T-shirt, uniform dry cleaning fee, and the uniform usage fee. A pay to participate fee of \$50.00 is also required by the district. This fee will be added to each student's yearly school fees and should not be paid directly to the band.

This year, camp dates are July 31-August 3. "Visitor's Day" will be Thurs. Aug. 3, from 6-7:00 p.m. After a great band performance, the students will leave with their parents. If students cannot leave with their parents, please contact Mr. Roemer or set up other transportation arrangements with other parents. School bus transportation will be provided to take the band to camp on Monday, July 31st.

It is imperative that all members of Band, Color Guard and Drum Majors attend! Absent members will not perform with the group at contests or football games. We have two competitions the first month of school next year. Any group, whether Music or Athletic, does not score victories with members who do not show up for practices or rehearsals. I expect, and this community expects, the finest marching band possible.

The band camp application must be in by Friday, May 5. If we do not receive the band camp application by May 5, I will not be able to chart a position on the field for those students. I also need a \$100.00 non-refundable camp deposit by May 5 (checks payable to Ross High School Band).

All students must have a physical examination and have a doctor's signature on the form. The physical exam form must be turned in this summer before camp. Any student who disobeys the rules of the camp and/or causes any disturbance during the stay will be sent home immediately, regardless of the time of day or night, at their parents' expense. All forms and deposit in by May 5 – except the physical. If you have any questions or concerns about band camp, please feel free to contact me.

Schedule:

Depart: All luggage should be in the RHS band room by 10 am on Monday, July 31. We will depart at 10:30 am.

Return: Each student should return with their parents after the Visitor's Day performance at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, Aug. 3.

Luggage: All baggage will be kept to a minimum!! With a marching band as large as ours, space is limited: ONE (1) suitcase; a blanket, a sleeping bag and an instrument per person. (iPods and phones etc. are permitted.)

Clothing: Suggested list: 2 sweatshirts, light jacket, blue jeans, shorts, T-shirts, 4 pair of socks, towel, a washcloth, a comfortable pair of marching shoes plus an extra pair, swim suit, raincoat, and sunglasses.

Toilet Articles: Toothpaste, soap, brush, deodorant, insect repellent, sunscreen, etc. **Snacks:** Students are permitted to bring snacks with them to camp. There will be a "Pizza Night" on the last night at camp: each cabin chips in for pizzas. You may bring drinks, but not "energy type" drinks aka Rockstar, Redbull, etc.

Miscellaneous: It is strongly suggested that valuables NOT be brought to camp; such things as expensive jewelry, cameras, etc. If these items are brought to camp, they are brought at YOUR risk. Cell phones are permitted during certain hours. Spending money - we will stop on the way up for lunch at a fast food restaurant.

Band Camp Agreement

This is an agreement between individual members of the Ross High School Marching Band (including auxiliaries) and the band director. It encompasses the band member's conduct from the time s/he leaves for band camp until the time s/he returns.

As a member of the Ross High School Marching Rams, I agree to the following:

- 1. I will follow all rules set forth by the camp counselors.
- 2. I will always treat the chaperones with respect.
- 3. I will not engage in any hazing (initiating) of a band member, and I understand I will lose all free time for 24 hours after a breach of this rule. If less than 24 hours remain of band camp, the band director and principal will decide on the punishment.
- 4. I will not enter any other cabin besides my own without the express permission of the assigned chaperone. This will result in loss of free time for 24 hours. If less than 24 hours exist for band camp see #3.
- 5. Except in an emergency, I will not leave my cabin after curfew. I understand this to be a very serious breach of band camp rules, and if caught out or reported missing after curfew by a chaperone, I will expect the following:
 - 1. I will lose all of my free time for the 24 hours after I am caught
 - 2. I may not be eligible for my band award for the rest of the school year
 - 3. I may be unable to participate in the first two performances of the band (with resultant grade cuts for non-participation) during the school year.
- 6. I will not bring or invite anyone to Camp Lebanon (except my parents/guardians) until the last day, when they will be welcomed from 6pm until we leave.
- 7. I will conduct myself according to the student conduct rules of Ross High School and those set forth in the Ross High School Band Manual. My/our signature on this document indicates that I/we have read, understand and will abide by the rules set forth in this agreement.
