#### What to Bring

On the first day (Sunday) please wear appropriate clothing & shoes for the trip to camp and marching practice. Pack your instrument, enough clothing for 3 days and nights (check extended weather forecast), 6-7 pairs of socks, an extra pair of shoes for marching, swim suit, rain coat, 3 towels & wash cloths, toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, comb, deodorant, insect repellent, sunscreen, sunglasses or hat, sleeping bag, pillow, and any other personal items you may need. Do not bring stereo equipment, expensive jewelry, expensive cameras, etc.. Finally, please keep all baggage to a minimum!

Students must be at the HS band room by 9:30am on July 28th. A bus will bring the students to camp. Parents will bring their child home on Aug. 1st, after the band performs about 6pm. If you like, bring a lawn chair and come early to get a good spot to watch the performance.

#### **Important**

Each band member should bring spending money for a lunch stop on the bus ride to camp (this is a fast food restaurant stop), and they will also need at least \$8.00 to \$10.00 (If possible, send sin-

gles) to buy pizza at the Pizza Party on Tuesday night.

### **Tag Day**

Tag day is set for Sat., Aug., 23 from 9am-4:30pm. All high school band and guard members are required to participate. This is the largest fundraiser to benefit the band and guard directly. It is organized through Mr. Roemer, not the band boosters.

Tag Day is an annual fundraiser, where the band & guard members go door to door throughout the neighborhoods of the Ross Local School District asking for monetary support of the band program.
